The PCT makes it easier and more cost-effective for companies and inventors to seek patent protection for their inventions in multiple countries. A single international patent application under the PCT has legal effect in all of the countries bound by the Treaty.

If you are looking to take your business overseas but aren't sure how to protect your intellectual property (IP) rights or if you want to keep up with new developments in global IP services then join WIPO's roving seminars in order to get a clear idea on the PCT Tools you need to protect and leverage your intangible assets, and to grow your business.

Experts from WIPO & IP offices will present an overview of the PCT system and its advantages for the applicants, the patent Offices and the general public. The roving seminars will also be the occasion to help Indian user to create their accounts and to access the ePCT system and other patent tools, which allows users to file and manage their international applications online.
