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4. The other entitlements of the officers including medical facilities will be as laid down in the orders issued by the Ministry of Finance/Ministry of External Affairs from time to time.

5. The cost on travel, DSA, hotel accommodation in respect of the aforementioned officers will be borne by the Government of India during the period of their deputation. DSA etc. may be paid to them by PMI, Geneva. Hotel accommodation will be arranged by the PMI, Geneva. This sanction will be treated as an authority for the payment.

6. The officers will furnish a report on his visit after return from abroad.

All admissible expenditure in respect of officers mentioned at Para-1 above towards Air passage/TA/DS/Airport Tax/Medical Expenses/Mobile Phone/excess baggage etc. will be debitable to the Major Head 2852:80:104 – Scheme for Investment Promotion – 01.01.12, Foreign Travel Expenses under Demand No. 11 of the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade for the year 2022-23.
